

2015 NOMINATIONS TO THE
NORTH PACIFIC FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL

Effective February 20, 2015 a Washington State obligatory seat will become vacant on the North Pacific Fishery Management Council. When an obligatory Council member seat becomes vacant before the expiration of its term, the Magnuson-Stevens Act requires the governor of the state represented by that Council to submit the names of at least three qualified individuals to fill the Council seat. Listed below are Washington's nominations for the seat in alphabetical order.
