



SUMMARY OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS
Relating to Amendment, and Surrender-Reissuance of Federal Fishery Permits (FFPs)
Prepared December 2012

Federal regulations at 50 CFR 679.4 limit the amendment or re-issuance of Federal Fisheries Permits during a permit cycle that have specific endorsements. These regulations became effective beginning January 2012. The table below provides a summary of the permit amendment and surrender-reissuance limitations effective with these regulations. It is not intended as, and should be not used as, a substitute for the regulations.

A Federal Fisheries Permit may be voluntarily surrendered in accordance with 50 CFR 679.4 (a)(9) or amended under 50 CFR 679.4(b)(4)(iii), EXCEPT as specifically prohibited at 50 CFR 679.4(b)(4)(ii) and (iii), as shown in the following table:
